PARKING AND PEDESTRIAN UPDATE

Following our request for a road safety audit in May 2023, Surrey County Council Highways Department conducted a survey of the parking and road conditions last week.

The team were onsite during a collection time to monitor how parents are using the road, look at pedestrian crossings areas, as well as investigate parking conditions around the school area.

We await their report into proposed road safety improvements but have been advised that actioning this may take some time.

In the meantime we continue to ask you to walk or cycle where possible, and if you need to drive, to park considerately, to be aware of pedestrians, and to use the local "one way" system at busy times.



IS MY CHILD TOO ILL FOR SCHOOL?

It can be tricky deciding whether or not to keep your child off school when they're unwell. If you are unsure visit www.nhs.uk/live-well/is-my-child-too-ill-for-school/ for guidance.

Children with diarrhoea or vomiting should stay away from school until they have not been sick or had diarrhoea for at least 2 days (48 hours).

Remember to let the school office know by 8.30am if your child is absent.

Children can come into school dressed as their favourite book character. There will be a prize for the best costume in each year group. Be creative!

MEASLES

Cases of measles are rising across England, including among children. It's an infection that spreads very easily and for some people can cause serious problems.

There's no specific medical treatment for measles, so it's important to get vaccinated as it's the best protection against becoming seriously unwell. The MMR Vaccination is free on the NHS.

Measles usually starts with cold-like symptoms, followed by a rash a few days later. Some people may also get small spots in their mouth. Find out more on the NHS website.


SEND UPDATE

Family Support Worker Come & Ask session

Do you need help with sleep routines or fussy eaters? Is your child showing signs of anxiety or challenging behaviour? Is there a specific area around home life and meeting your child's needs you would like some support with? Maybe you just need reassurance that you are doing the best for your child. This is the perfect opportunity to have an informal conversation with a Family Support Worker from our Trust.

Come & Ask sessions

Our Kite Family Support Workers will be holding Come & Ask sessions fortnightly during the Autumn term. One-hour appointments are available every other Thursday morning between 9:00am and 1:30pm. During the Come & Ask session, you will have the opportunity to share what the concern is, discuss it and look at ways to address the situation.
